

# **DERRY TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS**

## **Minutes, May 4, 2010 Regular Meeting**

**7:00 p.m.**

Chairman Vincent DeCario called the regular meeting of the Derry Township Supervisors to order in the Municipal Building at 5321 Route 982, Derry, PA at 7:00 p.m. and lead the group with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Motion was made by David Slifka and seconded by Daniel Rullo to adjourn the previous meeting. Voting: Vincent DeCario-yes, David Slifka-yes, and Daniel Rullo-yes  
Motion carried.

Members present were: Vincent DeCario, David Slifka, and Daniel Rullo-Supervisors; Terry Giannini, Code Enforcement Officer and John Rushford, Solicitor.

Announcements: PennDOT will be closing the intersection of Route 22 and Garrigan Hill for paving through May 26<sup>th</sup>.

We are having a problem with people leaving recycling materials such as glass, plastic, and cans outside the fence at the newspaper collection site. These materials can only be brought to the municipal building during business hours and can only be accepted from township residents. The Supervisors are asking for the cooperation of the residents in order to keep the program.

2010 Census – 82% participation rate for Derry Township. May 1<sup>st</sup> Census takers began door-to-door visits for residents who did not return the census form. Census takers will attempt to visit up to three (3) times and attempt to reach households by phone three (3) times. The Supervisors are asking for cooperation with census takers.

The meeting was open to the public for comments: Irene Cinibulk questioned Mr. Rullo regarding the state convention in Hershey. Mr. Rullo gave a report.

Peg Ament of Loyalhanna questioned the time for burning and suggested an earlier starting time be investigated. The Supervisors said they will review the matter.

Motion was made by Daniel Rullo and seconded by David Slifka to approve Resolution No. 525-2010 authorizing the transfer of Liquor License No. R-3386 from the City of Monessen to the Township of Derry.

Attorney Gregory Nichols, who represents Mr. Knurowski related to the above liquor license, stated Mr. Knurowski may wish to assign his rights to an entity that has not yet been formed but should be by the end of this week. Mr. Nichols asked the Board to grant permission to the Township Secretary, upon procuring either an LLC or Corporation, to amend the resolution to allow the transfer to that entity.

Motion was made by Daniel Rullo and seconded by David Slifka to amend Resolution No. 525-2010 to allow the liquor license transfer from Mr. Knurowski to the LLC or corporation created by Mr. Knurowski.
